



Dr. Sarandis Mitropoulos is an Associate Professor of "Management Information Systems" at the Department of Regional Development of the School of Economics of the Ionian University (from 01/10/2018, while from 01/03/2018 he was at the same level in the Department of Business Administration of former TEI of the Ionian Islands, in which he was president and vice president). From 05/19-08 / 20 he was an associate member of the Department of Regional Development in the Research Committee of the Ionian University, while from 08/20 he is an associate member of the General Assembly of ELIDEK (Hellenic Centre for Research and Innovation).

He holds a PhD in Electrical and Computer Engineering from the National Technical University of Athens (with honours and a scholarship from IKY). His doctorate thesis concerned the Integrated Management of Distributed Information Systems, Computer Systems and Networks, as a Distributed Architecture Service.

He holds a two-year master's degree in Business Administration for Executives, with honours, from the Athens University of Economics and Business with a dissertation in the Formulation, Synchronization and Evaluation of Business and IT Strategies.

He holds a degree in Electrical Engineering from the National Technical University of Athens, with specialization in "Informatics and Computer Engineering" and a degree of very good.

Since 2004 he is a senior research associate at the Department of Informatics of the University of Piraeus, participating in research and development projects, teaching and supervising students' projects at postgraduate (master & Ph.D.) and undergraduate level.

From 04/2002 to 02/2018, he was a specialist in Informatics at the Deposits and Loans Fund (seconded to A.A.D.E. last year), which is supervised by the Greek Ministry of Finance.

Prior to joining the public sector (1996-2002), he had worked and collaborated with major IT and Communications companies, in providing technical and project management, as well as, business development management, in integrated solutions projects in the areas of advanced systems and network management, telecommunications and telematics services, security and information systems.

He has taught computer programming for three years at the National Technical University of Athens in the Department of Shipbuilding and Mechanical Engineering, as well as at the Hellenic Productivity Centre (ELKEPA) to graduates of universities and technical institutes.

He has published extensively in international scientific journals and conferences and has been a reviewer, respectively. He has also been a member of Program Committees and Session Chair of Scientific Conferences.

He is a member of the Editorial Board of the International Journal of Business and Systems Research.

He has won 1st award for excellent publication in the international journal of "Information Management and Computer Security" (Emerald Publishers, 2011).
