## Announcement of Funding Lists and Call for Scholarships to PhD Candidates

The evaluation process under the 3rd Call for Scholarships to PhD Candidates was completed with the issue of the lists of applications to be funded. In total, three hundred and ten (310) proposals from all Scientific Areas will receive funding, totalling 8 million euros.

On the occasion of the success of the previous calls, the Hellenic Foundation for Research and Innovation (H.F.R.I.), shortly before the change of the year, had proceeded to the issue of the **fourth (4th) Call for Scholarships to PhD Candidates**, continuing thus the strengthening of unrestricted research and young researchers in the country.

The Call aims mainly to support PhD Candidates in order to conduct high-level research. In this framework, H.F.R.I. finances scholarships, with a total budget of **5** million euros, in order to support PhD Candidates in the elaboration of their doctoral dissertations in Higher Educational Institutions (AEI) and Higher Military Educational Institutions (ASEI) in Greece. The start date for submissions was set on

**01/03/2022** and **until the end of the same month** the interested parties are invited to submit an application through the H.F.R.I.'s online portal (<a href="https://hfri.grnet.gr/">https://hfri.grnet.gr/</a>).
