Announcement of the 6th Call for Action “Science and Society” entitled “Current Nutritional Awareness”

The Hellenic Foundation for Research and Innovation (H.F.R.I.), today, Thursday, October 3rd, 2024, issued the **6th Call for Action “Science and Society” entitled “Contemporary Nutritional Consciousness”**, furthering its mission to support research activity in Greece, without thematic or geographical limitations.

This Call’s main objective is to disseminate and promote to the society at large the research work that has been produced or is in progress by/at research institutions in the country regarding nutrition, and in particular, the safety, ethics of production and consumption as well as the reduction of food waste. The Action aims to inform and educate on issues of food awareness, consumer and nutritional behaviour, aspiring to reduce food waste.

From Wednesday, 30 October 2024, at 12 p.m. (EEST) until Tuesday, 3 December 2024, at 1 p.m. (EEST), all interested parties will be able to submit their Proposals exclusively through the H.F.R.I. Portal (<https://portal.H.F.R.I.gr/>). The total budget for the Call amounts to 1.000.000,00€, and the duration of each Project may vary from 18 to 24 months.

About H.F.R.I.

The Hellenic Foundation for Research and Innovation (H.F.R.I.) was established (Law 4429/2016) in response to the vital need for supporting Greek scientists. It is a legal person governed by private law, monitored by the Ministry of Development. H.F.R.I. aims to promote research and innovation in the country. In particular, it aims to evaluate and fund unrestricted research, namely research activities, research infrastructure and their technological applications, arising from scientific curiosity, without any thematic exclusions or geographical limitations, having scientific quality and excellence as a sole criterion.
